Preach the Word

2 Tim. 4:1-8

The Book of 2 Timothy

Theme:

Elders are to preach the word, rebuke, exhort and evangelize, regardless of the circumstances or what people may or may not want to hear.

Introduction:

As his ministry comes to a close, Paul charges Timothy to fullfill his own ministry through sound preaching, teaching, and exhortation. This passage is the dramatic pinnacle of Paul's instruction to Timothy and one of the last statements we ever hear from Paul.

Shepherding the Sheep

Elders: Preach and teach the Word. Do not get distracted. Keep the main thing the main thing. Believers: Insist upon sound preaching and teaching of the Word. Know the Gospel and pass it on to others.
